### Education & Cultural Exchange

- Develop School visit program with local schools
- Initiate HYC-Keaukaha Scholarship fund
- Sharing Cultural history and knowledge in the areas of food preparation, employment, leisure pleasures (traditional & contemporary games), music, sports etc.
  - Implementation: To be introduced and continuously fostered at Kokua Keaukaha events. We will highlight teaching of our history and make Hawaiian language classes, games and dancing available to members and staff.
- Increasing and maintaining native Hawaiian plants and develop signage of historic significance on property.
  - Implementation: Build keiki scavenger hunt providing fun rewards in learning incorporating plan finding and other cultural discoveries.
- Highlight the properties Fishpond as a resource for education in traditional and contemporary food preparation of local products
- Monthly use of designated area on web site and newsletter to feature portions of cultural study
- Provide Internships opportunities for community residents at the club by joining KS's program
- Develop a partnership with Keaukaha Canoe club to establish participation in local traditions and bring the Club back on the water.
- Provide site for an annual joint Craft Fair and or Ho'olaule'a (Prince Kuhio Day) Cross utilize to fundraise for Scholarship
- Continue the long-standing effort to provide a safe environment for the annual Grad Night for our local high schools

### Networking

- Develop relationships with community organizations such as Rotary, Exchange Clubs, Chamber of Commerce, and other Business organizations
- Organize volunteer drives within the club and participate in community charity events.

### Artwork and integration of History in art plan:

- Kiosk development and Web design to integrate the cultural Study into Club/app development
- Use entrance and dining room walls for maps and historic artwork
- Partner with KSBE to build a replica of traditional fishing tools intended to enhance the school property visits for educational purposes
- Develop presentation format to orient Club members and to share cultural responsibility of the club and its members (will be designed to also be a piece in the school program and staff onboarding)
